



MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

BETWEEN

THE MINISTRY FOR HEALTH OF THE REPUBLIC OF MALTA

AND

THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH OF MONTENEGRO

IN THE FIELDS OF HEALTH AND MEDICAL SCIENCES

The Ministry for Health of the Republic of Malta and the Ministry of Health of Montenegro (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"), in order to strengthening mutual relations and cooperation in the fields of health and medical sciences

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Parties shall encourage cooperation in the fields of health and medical sciences on the basis of equality and mutual benefit and within the framework of their respective national legislations.

Article 2

Cooperation between the Parties shall take place through the following areas of cooperation:

- a) Strengthening health care systems;
- b) Professional training of health professionals through participation in symposia; conferences, seminars and other events important for health, organised in the Parties;
- c) Pharmaceuticals and medical devices;
- d) Health promotion and disease prevention;
- e) Epidemiological control of communicable and non-communicable diseases;
- f) Other mutually agreed forms of cooperation in the fields of public healthcare and medical sciences.

Article 3

The Parties shall cooperate by mutual agreement in the fields of health and medical sciences by the following methods:

- a) Exchange of information and experiences;
- b) Exchange of delegations, experts and health personnel;
- c) Providing communication and coordination between related health institutions;
- d) Encouraging the participation of specialists at congresses, conferences, symposia and other scientific meetings to be organised by either of the Parties;
- e) Exchange of information on new equipment, products and technological development related to medicine, health and medical sciences.

Article 4

For the purpose of this Memorandum, the Parties shall periodically prepare plans of cooperation that will be establish formats of cooperation, content, conditions and methods of cooperation for a specific time period.

Article 5

This Memorandum is agreed for an indefinite period and shall enter into force upon signature.

Any Party may terminate this Memorandum, by giving written notice to the other Party of its intention to terminate the Memorandum, at least six months in advance

Termination of this Memorandum shall not prejudice the completion of agreed activities under this Agreement and initiated activities prior to its termination, unless the Parties agree otherwise.

Signed in Valletta on the 18th day of May of the year 2016, in two original copies, in the English and Montenegrin languages, both equally authentic. In the case of divergence in interpretation, the English text shall prevail
