



PROTOCOL

On the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations Between the Republic of Cape Verde and the Republic of Malta

In order to develop their relations on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality, territorial integrity, non-interference in each other's internal affairs, the peaceful settlement of disputes with the purposes and principles established in the United Nations Charter, and with the relevant provisions of the 1961 Vienna Convention that regulates diplomatic relations between States.

The Republic of Cape Verde and the Republic of Malta have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as from the date of this Protocol.

Both Parties have agreed that the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 shall apply to diplomatic relations between them.
